## MANDATORY PAINTING RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Space must be first primed with a water-based exterior latex.
2. Paints can only be water-based exterior latex.
3. No spray, reflective or fluorescent permitted.
4. You will provide your own paint. Consider sharing colors and expenses with others.
5. You must leave a 3" border within the parking lines of the space.

### PROHIBITED

- No offensive language, gestures, pictures, symbols or abbreviations.
- No negative or rude language (be kind).
- No political references.
- No double-meanings.
- You may use YOUR NAME. If you want to use a nickname it must be approved. A friend's name is NOT allowed.
- Prohibited items will be painted over at the discretion of administration. Disciplinary action may be taken, and you could forfeit your right to a parking space and/or the privilege of parking on campus.

### IDEAS

- Your name
- Show your school spirit, your sport, jersey number, extra-curricular activity, hobby
- Show your creativity
- Keep it classy!

*Think of your personalized space as a t-shirt you want to wear to school. No reference to drugs, alcohol, smoking, gangs, etc. Keep it classy! You can use your name, jersey number, instrument you play, hobbies, favorite quote. Your spot should be fun and reflect who you are! Depending on what you do, your spot might need more than one day to work on. Organize your work.*



### CATCHING CONTEST

The painted design that "CATCHES OUR EYE" will be refunded the \$100 fee. We will be looking to see who has the most unique, creative, and thoughtful design! There will only be one lucky winner!

### PAINTING DAYS: July 15-19, 2024 between 7am and 7pm

Realize you might have to come to school twice as your design dries. It does take a couple of hours for your first coat to dry. Bring plenty of water with you. The days will be hot and you will need water. Restroom facilities will be provided. You will realize that the process takes longer than you anticipated.

You can have friends and family help you paint your spot. You will be thankful for the extra help.

# HOW TO GET STARTED

## What to do first:

By July 11, 2024, you need to email the following items to: [nicholas.glueck@lpsb.org](mailto:nicholas.glueck@lpsb.org).

1. Your Request form
2. Your Design
3. What day(s) between July 15-19 and what time you plan to paint. Your time can change if needed, but be sure to let us know of any changes.

You will be notified by email of your approval and any comments from Administration.

## PAINT DAY DETAILS

### On the day you arrive:

Check in and let us know you are on campus. Restrooms will be available, but cleaning brushes will not be permitted!

### Be sure to bring:

- A copy of your approved design to use as a template. **You must follow the design, no changes allowed.**
- A broom to clean your spot before painting. (This will save you lots of time). Blowers are not permitted as they can mess up a neighbor's design.
- Paint, paintbrushes, paint rollers, bowls for paint colors, painter's tape, any other supplies. Think about where you will put your paint can down at and bring a box lid or something else to put your supplies on for protection and clean-up materials.
- Painter's tape will be used to section off your space and will help to scale your design. You must leave a 3" border inside the pre-existing parking stripes. A ruler or tape measure will help to mark these boundaries.
- Other suggested items: bottled water to keep you hydrated, sunscreen, pop-up tent to help you cool off. A towel or gardeners cushion to sit on or kneel on while painting. Hula hoop for drawing large circles. A trash bag for clean-up. Paper towels for clean up of brushes and/or to wrap paint brushes in. **You will not be permitted to wash any cleaning supplies at school.**

### Suggestions:

Paint can be expensive so there are some tips to help keep the cost down:

1. Ask family or neighbors if they have any paint lying around that they don't need.
2. Home supply stores usually have paint in the clearance section that are deeply discounted.
3. Talk to your friends to see what colors they are using and share your paint.
4. Simplify your design: more colors = more money.

## REMINDER

**There are NO REFUNDS after you have painted your spot. If you paint something inappropriate or against the rules and regulations, it will be painted over and you will face disciplinary actions.**

- I hereby agree to abide by all of the following rules and regulations corresponding to my privilege of having a reserved painted parking spot:
- I know I must submit my design by July 11, 2024.
- I know I must pay by July 11, 2024.
- Upon purchasing my parking spot, I will only use water based exterior latex paint.
- I understand that I must check-in before I begin to paint.
- I know I am not allowed to use spray paint, reflective paint, or fluorescent paint of any kind.
- I will only paint within the marked parking space.
- I know I have to bring my own brushes and painting supplies to decorate my spot.
- I will not park in another parking space that is not assigned to me.
- I will not permit someone else to park in my space.
- I will only paint my approved design following the guidelines in this packet.
- I understand that my painted design must be completed during the school approved day and time.
- If I do not abide by any of these rules, I realize my parking spot will be taken away and will be painted over. I will not receive a refund and could receive disciplinary consequences.
